Principal's Report

- A. School Improvement Plan
 - a. Today the SAC will approve the School Improvement Plan, now called the Continuous Improvement Management System.
 - b. The CIM will be changed throughout the year according to need-base.
 - c. Ventura Elementary does not have enough of a population of migrant students to have a subgroup. Migrant students in our school may be found in other subgroups such as ELL or ESE.
 - d. We have the help of United Way, which provides help in clothing, food, etc.
 - e. The CIM will be available at the front office for anyone; it will also be linked on the school website.
 - f. A summary of the FCAT data for the last two years was presented.
 - g. The state established goals were also presented for Writing, Reading, Math and Science.
 - h. Mr. Clark explained that there are also goals for subgroups and presented them.
 - i. The ESE and ELL subgroups decreased in the data and that is why the focus of the CIM is on working with these two populations.
 - j. Teachers are being trained in best instructional practices by attending Modeling Sessions.
 - k. Daily 5 training and Math solutions training is also being provided.
 - l. The Extended Learning Program is targeting the bottom 25 percentile of students and the "B
